The DO's

DO arrive 5-10 minutes early. Just relax, enjoy the view, and get a real feel for the location. This allows more time for you to take everything in, at and around the venue.

DO call if you expect to arrive late. I'm here to make the best use of your time and a phone call can help me make any adjustments that might be necessary to maximize your time.

DO allow for enough time to tour the venue in its entirety. When making your appointment, please take into consideration that it typically takes a good hour for a complete tour. This will help you better schedule your time. We want you to be relaxed and enjoy your visit.

DO take as many pictures as you need in order to remember the venue! Photos are a great way to remember the special aspects of our venue and should assist you when taking your final decision.

DO ask questions! I love when a couple comes in with a list of questions! It lets me provide them with the most relevant information about our venue and to help personalize their wedding day.

The DON'Ts

DON'T assume anything during the visit. If you have any concerns or if there is anything you do not understand, please just ask. I'm more than happy to answer questions or explain any aspect in more detail.

DON'T bring a large group of people for your site visit. I understand how important it is that your families view the event spaces (especially if they are contributing financially). However, in order for you to get the most out of your site visit, we recommend you limit your group to those who will be involved throughout your wedding planning process.
